

Our Programs

After School:

The program provides after-school enrichment during the school year at the elementary schools and middle schools. The program is open from the end of the school day until 6 pm.

\$75 weekly fee or \$15 per afternoon.

Before School:

Before school care is provided at some of the elementary schools. The program is open from 7 a.m. until the start of school.

\$40 weekly fee or \$8 per morning.

Early Dismissal:

The program is open from dismissal time until 6:00 pm during the November Conference Week Only . There is a \$20 charge for each afternoon. This option is for students currently enrolled in ELP.

One Hour Early Release:

The afternoon program will open one hour earlier. Students will follow their usual enrollment schedule. No additional charge will be added to the regular fee.

Delayed Opening:

The morning program is open at 9:00 am when the District has a 2 hour delay.

Delayed Opening Fee: \$8.00 per morning.

Extended Learning Program

Daily Routine:

After a brief snack break, children are given a full hour of homework time. Students work on homework assignments and special projects, independently or with assistance from ELP staff. Students who do not have homework assignments engage in reading and other quiet activities during the homework time.

Following homework time, children participate in enrichment activities to keep them stimulated and wanting to come back for more!

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Expectations

Parent Expectations:

- Children will be cared for in a safe environment.
- Parents will be informed of any misbehavior or important information about their child.
- Parents will be informed about special events by the Program Manager or Site Facilitator.

The Program expects that:

- Parents will keep their child's enrollment records and telephone numbers up to date.
- Parents will pick up their child at the designated time.
- Parents will sign their children into the morning program and out of the afternoon program daily.

Children may expect to:

- Participate in a safe and supportive environment.
- Use Program equipment, materials, and facilities on an equal basis.
- Receive nurturing care from staff who are actively engaged with them.

Expectations from Children:

- Take responsibility for their actions and behaviors.
- Respect staff & peers, and follow all Program rules.

Other Information

Health Education:

All medical concerns should be listed on the child's registration form. The Special Care Medical Needs Form is required to be completed if your child has any health care needs. If your child has special learning needs, please speak to the Program Manager at Registration.

Payments:

Payments are required weekly at the site where your child attends ELP. Some program sites receive grant assistance. Our program accepts the Care 4 Kids Child Care Certificate. Families are required to make the full weekly payments until Care 4 Kids approval is confirmed.

Program Changes:

Program schedule changes must be made prior to the effective date. Changes must be a minimum of four (4) weeks or longer with a limit of three (3) schedule changes per school year. Any changes in excess of three (3) will incur a fee of \$15.00 per change. No changes are accepted after May 4th.

Frequently Asked Questions



Question:

Is the program open on snow days?

Answer:

When schools are closed due to inclement weather or other emergencies, the Extended Learning Programs are closed.

Question:

How soon after registering can my child start ELP?

Answer:

Registrations must be completed and processed by 12:00 noon on Wednesdays in order to start the program on Monday of the following week. The exceptions to the rule are: beginning of the year start up and families having an outstanding balance.

Question:

If my child is absent from the Program, will I still have to pay?

Answer:

Weekly payments are expected even if your child is absent from the program. Students who are absent due to illness for five (5) consecutive days, will be exempt from payment with a doctor's note.
