

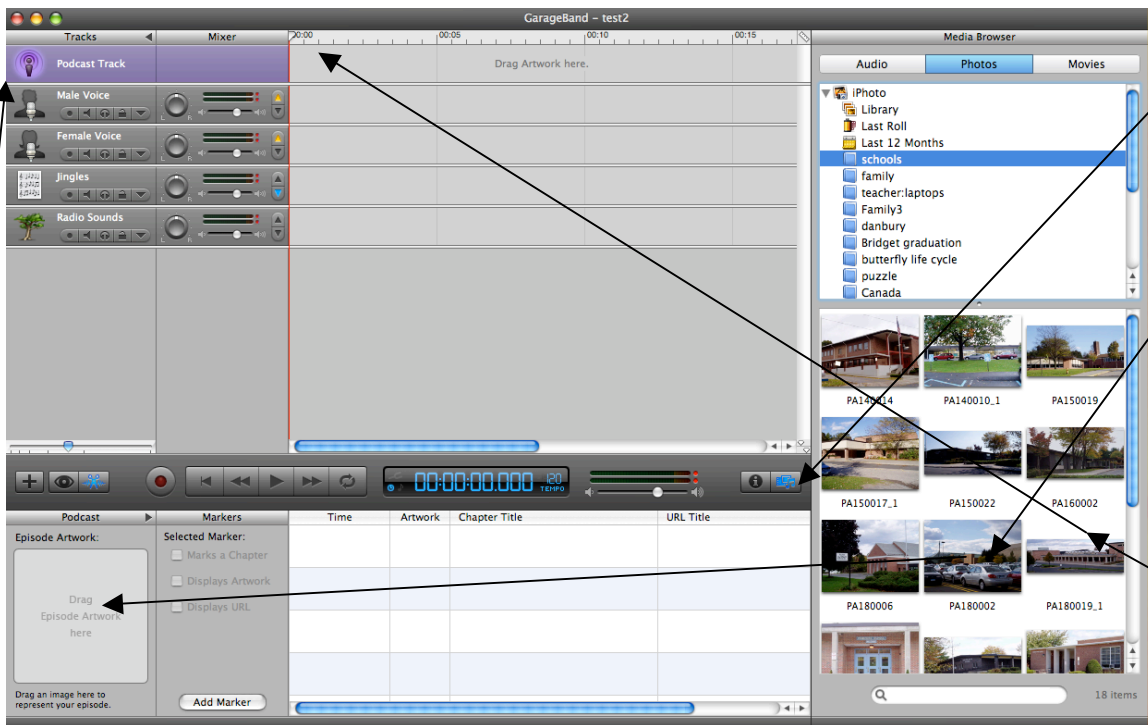


Create Enhanced Podcasts using Garageband and iWeb

Enhanced Podcasts are audio files with images that you can download or listen to over the Internet. Viewers can subscribe to your podcasts and it will download into the viewer's iTunes.

Add the artwork:

- Open Garageband and select Create a Podcast.
- In the Podcast work area . . . add photos to the podcast.



Click on the media browser to see your iPhoto Library.

Drag a photo into the Episode Artwork area. This image will appear on the first page of the Podcast.

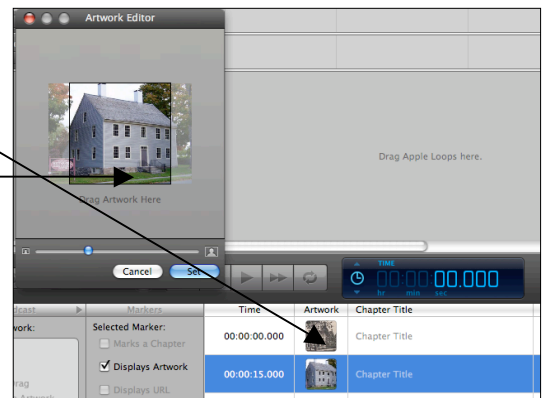
Drag the same/or different photo into the Podcast Track. You can add more than one photo and they will change as the audio plays.

*If the Art Episode area isn't showing, double click on the Podcast Track.

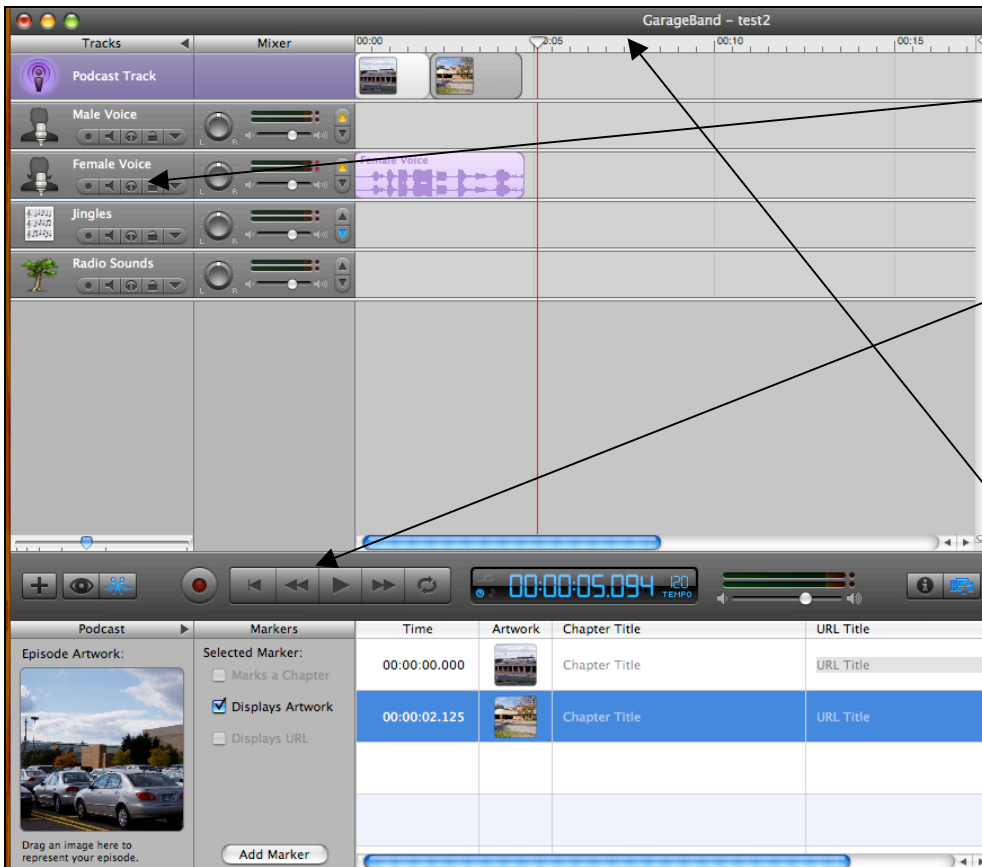
For the best results in showing your photos, you will want to edit the photo size to a square shape.

1. Double click on the photo in the chapter title list.
2. Move the "mask" to crop the photo into a square shape to better fit the image area in the Podcast.
3. Click on Set to crop the image.

*You can also constrain the size in iPhoto before using the photos in Garageband.



Record the Audio:



Click on the words in Female or Male Voice track.

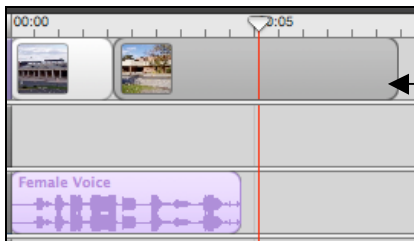
To record, click on the Red Circle and start talking!
You should see a purple voice track as you record. Talk loudly and slowly. Using an external microphone is suggested.

To stop recording, press the space bar.

Move the playhead back to the beginning and press the Play button to hear your recording.

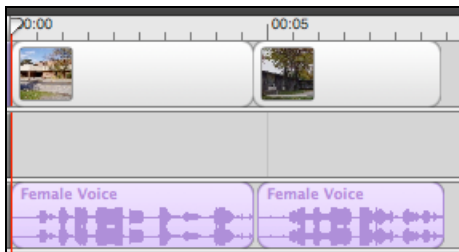
SAVE

- You may wish to shorten the length of time the picture is showing to match the length of the audio.



Click and drag at the end of the photo track to make the photo last longer or shorter.

- You can record more than once on the same track. If you want the audio to match the photo, stop the recording between each audio caption. This also makes it easier to rerecord a section if needed.



- Click on the view podcast button to show the actual podcast as it will look on the web.

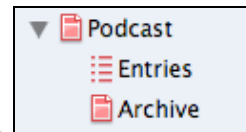


Play the podcast to make certain the timing is correct.

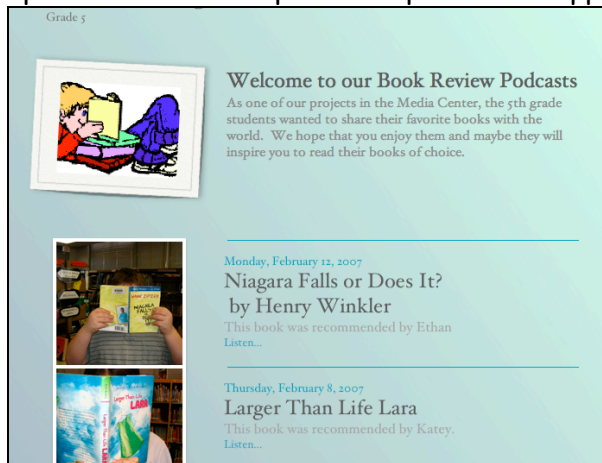
- SAVE

Send the Podcast to iWeb:

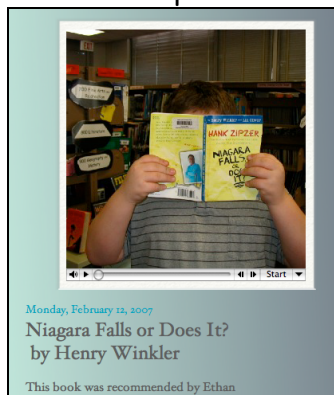
- From the Share Menu at the top of the screen in Garageband, select **Send Podcast to iWeb**. It will take a minute or so, be patient.
- iWeb will open and ask you to pick a Podcast page style. Choose the page template that you like best. Make certain you select a podcast page template.



- iWeb will create a set of pages: Podcast, Entries, and Archive.
- You will have to edit the text on the page to describe your podcast content.
 - Podcast page is what viewers will first see on the web. It will be a list of the podcast episodes. Each new podcast episode will appear at the top of the list.



- The Entries page is the individual Podcast where you can actually listen to the audio and see the photos.



- The Archive is a visual list of all the different podcast episodes you have recorded.



SAVE the iWeb pages:

- From the File Menu > Publish to a Folder and select the Sites Folder.
- Do NOT click on your name or any other folder inside the sites folder.

Subscription to the Podcast

- Podcasts are like radio or TV shows that are downloaded over the Internet. Users can download an individual podcast episode or subscribe to a podcast series. When you subscribe to a Podcast series, it will automatically come into your iTunes when a new episode is published.
- When you publish to iWeb, a subscription button will automatically be created on your Podcast page.
- In order for viewers to be able to subscribe to your podcast, the URL of your website must be saved in iWeb. When you publish to a folder, make certain the URL is in place.
