

**DANBURY BOARD OF EDUCATION
SITES & FACILITIES COMMITTEE MEETING
MARCH 27, 2013**

Kathy Molinaro, Chairperson, called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Radon testing completed – no problems.

Energy savings – CL&P rebate – meeting with CL&P representative regarding possible savings by combining various programs. Rich Jalbert and Joe Martino will see if the City is interested in working with us. Lighting at elementary schools have been untouched.

Elliot Isban of American Solar made a proposal to relamp 4 schools. Savings projected 1,072,598 over ten years. Possible rebate of \$105,000 from CL&P. Schools are King Street Intermediate, King Street Primary, Hayestown Avenue and Stadley Rough. He also presented an estimate of saving for Osborne Street offices. American Solar said it would look into a comprehensive energy and lighting program which would lead to more savings through rebates. Joe Martino stated he needs more time to evaluate this proposal. The Committee gave Elliot permission to proceed and get more information from CL&P.

Rich Jalbert provided the committee with his monthly update (attached), which will be distributed to the full Board.

Rich Jalbert investigated the Magnet School oil smell. City is conducting soil probes. The Health Department said there is no safety issue.

The meeting adjourned at 7:00 p.m.
