STUDENT REGISTRATION RESIDENT

All eligible resident students shall be permitted access to the Danbury Public Schools. At the time of student registration, the parent(s) or guardian(s) shall submit appropriate documentation to the school principal or their designee in order to establish that the student is a bona fide resident of Danbury.

A bona fide resident, for purposes of this policy, is defined as:

1. Any child who is residing in Danbury with their parent(s)
2. Any child who is residing in Danbury with their legal guardian(s)
3. A legally emancipated minor or a student eighteen years of age or older who is residing in Danbury
4. A child placed in a residence in Danbury by a public agency
5. A child living with a relative or non-relative in Danbury, as long as specified conditions are met
6. A child placed in a temporary shelter in Danbury
