STUDENTS LEAVING DURING THE SCHOOL DAY

Once a student has arrived at school, they are not permitted to leave the school building or school grounds before the close of the school day without permission of the principal or their designee.

The principal or their designee is authorized to grant permission for students to leave the school building or school grounds only on the presentation of a note or communication from the student's parent or guardian requesting that such permission be given. Students over the age of 18 may sign and present a note of their own.

There may be times when it is not possible to receive written notes from home due to extenuating circumstances, including ESL. In these cases, the principal or their designee should seek to contact the parents. If they are not able to, then they must use their best judgment in determining the validity of the request.
