TEXTBOOK LOANS TO NON-PUBLIC STUDENTS

The Board of Education, at the written request of any non-public elementary or secondary school pupil, including a kindergarten pupil, residing in and attending a non-public school in Danbury, or at the request of a parent, guardian, or authorized representative of such pupil, parent or guardian, shall make available for loan non-consumable textbooks currently in use in the public schools of Danbury to such pupil, free of charge, provided the loan of such textbook shall be requested for not less than one semester's use and copies are available in excess of current inventory.

The Superintendent of Schools, or designee, shall make arrangement for such loans of textbooks, and any other condition relative thereto.

It is the responsibility of the non-public school to return all loaned materials at the conclusion of the school year. It shall not be the responsibility of the individual students, but rather the responsibility of the non-public school to insure that 100 percent of the loan materials are returned.
