<p>A. Request for Non-Resident Enrollment in Danbury Public Schools</p> <p>Whenever a student enrolls in the Danbury Public Schools, the registration form will establish the legal address of the parent/guardian. If the parent/guardian is a resident of another community, the student will be classified as a non-resident student and denied free public education in Danbury.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The Superintendent of Schools may authorize a waiver to this policy if the following conditions (under Connecticut General Statutes 46-150d and 10-253a) are satisfied: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. The student can provide a certified court document establishing legal status as an emancipated minor;</li> <li>b. The student has been placed out by the Commission of Children and Youth Services or other agencies.</li> </ol> </li> <li>2. The Board of Education may, upon written application, provide school privileges on a tuition basis to any student whose legal residence is in another community. Tuition rates, equal to the per capita expense, have been established and are payable to the Board of Education on the following basis: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. 50% of the tuition shall be paid upon application;</li> <li>b. 50% of the tuition shall be due on January 1<sup>st</sup> of that school year;</li> </ol> </li> <li>3. The Board of Education may, upon written application, provide school privileges on a tuition-free basis to any student whose permanent residence is with a Danbury relative or non-relative. Board of Education authorization may be granted if the following conditions (under Connecticut General Statutes 10-253d) are satisfied:</li> </ol>		

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<p>a. The Danbury relative or non-relative declares under oath that the residency of the student will be permanent and without financial compensation;</p> <p>b. The parent/guardian of the student declares, under oath, that their child will reside in Danbury on a permanent basis and that the Danbury relative or non-relative will not receive financial compensation;</p> <p>c. The written declaration is notarized and complies with CTGS 53a-157, which classified false statements to public officials as a Class A misdemeanor.</p> <p><b>B. Request for Continued Enrollment for the Remainder of a School Year</b></p> <p>Whenever a student becomes a non-resident of Danbury during a school semester, the parent/guardian may request continued enrollment for the remainder of the semester without payment of tuition.</p> <p>The Superintendent of Schools, or a designee, may upon written application, authorize a non-resident student's continued enrollment in the Danbury Public Schools for the remainder of that school semester. Application for subsequent school years shall be handled in the same manner as outlined in Section A2 above.</p>
