<p>The senior citizens guest pass or “gold card” will be issued yearly at times and locations specified by the school administration.</p> <p>Applicants will be required to provide positive proof of date of birth.</p> <p>Applicants will be required to complete, at the time of application, a form consisting of name, address, phone number and ate of birth, and to testify that this information is correct.</p> <p>Upon issuance of the “gold card”, applicants will be required to sign the card in the presence of a school administrator or designee.</p> <p>The signing of such card will be a declaration that the applicant is cognizant that the card must be presented for free admission at each event to which entry is desired; that misuse of the card will result in its forfeiture; that the card is non-transferable and that a separate form of personal identification may be required upon presentation of the “gold card” for entry to a school activity.</p> <p>Each “gold card” may be restricted at certain performances of in-house presentations announced in advance by the administration in a news release.</p>
