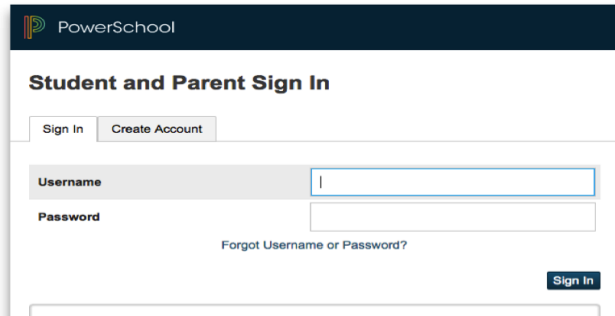


DHS Online Registration Instructions

1. Log onto PowerSchool: <https://danbury.powerschool.com/public/>



2. From the main portal screen, click on the "Class Registration" icon on the left-hand navigation menu.



3. Register for your core courses by clicking on the pencil icon to the right of each subject area:

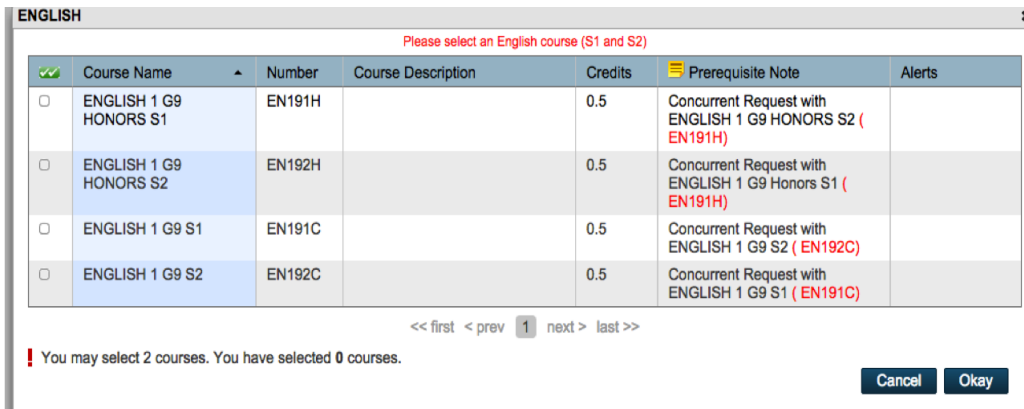

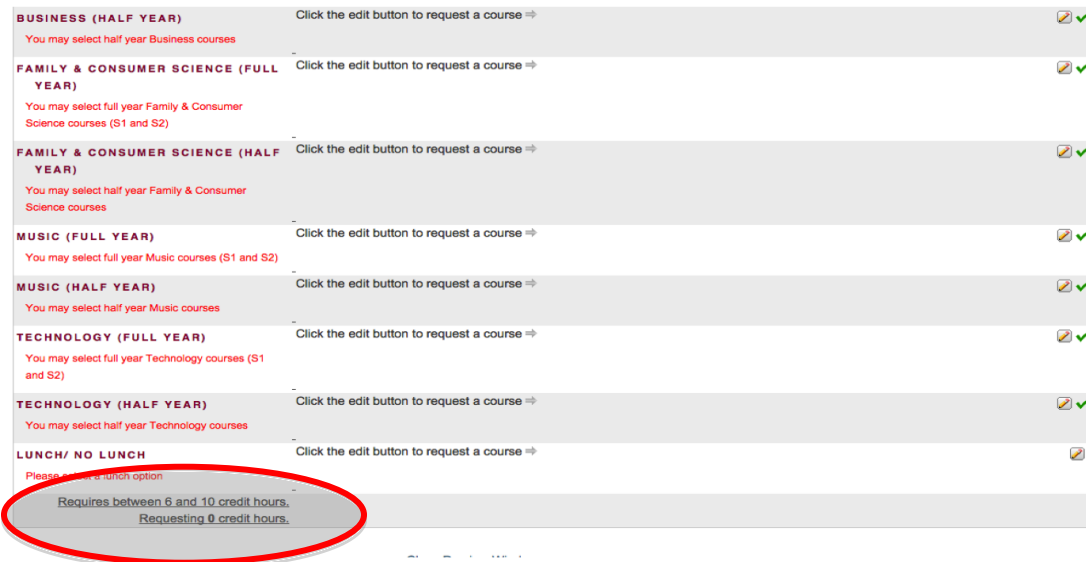
4. Remember to select both Semester 1 (S1) and Semester 2 (S2) at the same level (Honors, College Prep, or Advanced Placement) for each of your full-year core courses.

- Click “Okay” when finished to return to the main registration page to continue registering for your courses.



- Repeat the above steps to register for courses in various content areas.



- Those courses listed with a red exclamation point indicate that action is required and the selection criteria have not been met.
- Students may register for up to 8 credits, as noted on the bottom of the registration screen.
- When the desired courses have been requested, click on the “Submit” button to complete the registration requests.
