



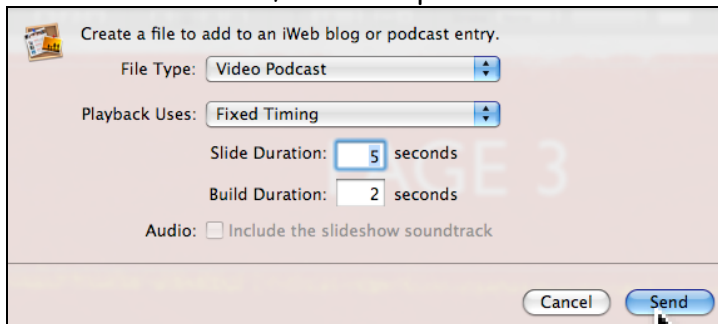
Use Keynote '08 Projects on the Web

Student Keynote projects can be saved in several ways to post on a website. Below are listed some options, from easiest to more difficult.

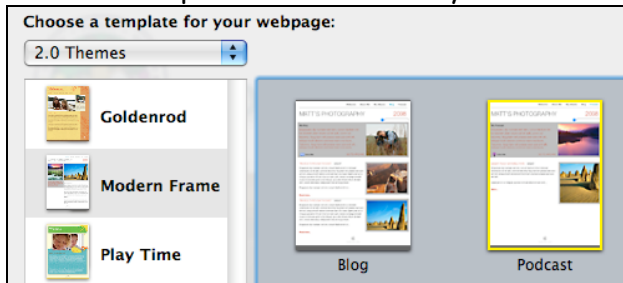
It is important that teachers do not publish projects to the web that contain full faced photos of students, or any student that does not have AUP permission to post their picture on the web.

Export to iWeb

- Create the Keynote. **SAVE**.
- From the File Menu, select Export > to iWeb



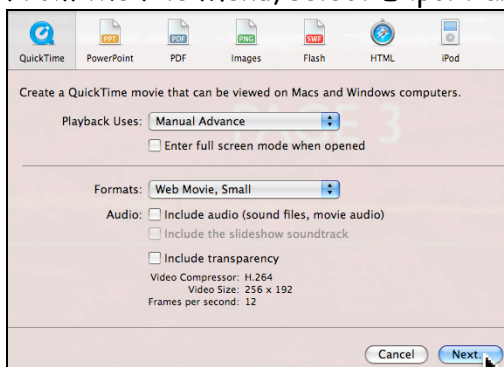
- Select a template that matches your site and select Podcast page:



- It will create a small movie type version of the Keynote on the Podcast page.
- As you add more student keynote presentations, they will continue to be added to the same Podcast page with the newest one on top.

Export as Quicktime Movie

- From the File Menu, select Export and click on the Quicktime icon.



- Change the file size to web movie small (this keeps the download time shorter). Click Next.
- Select where to save the movie, type a file name, and click Save.
- The movie can then be placed on a movie page in the iWeb site.
- The advantage to this method is that you can select the page and location on the page of the Keynote movie.

Other Export options:

- From the File Menu, select Export.
- You can choose from any of these export options, but all will require you to then import them onto the web page.
