

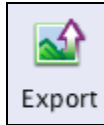


Use Pixie Drawing in other Projects

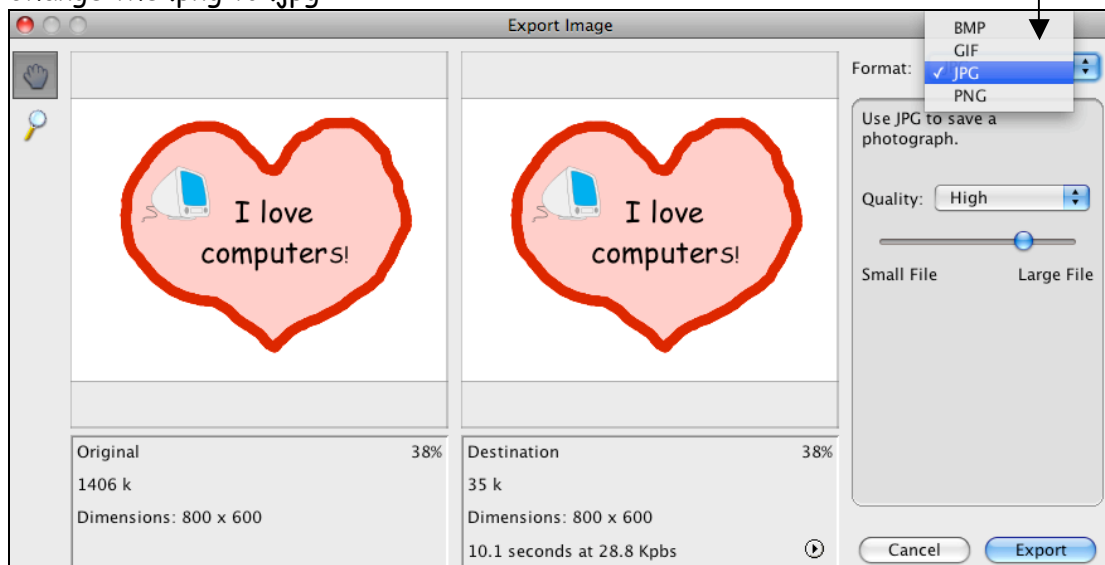
If you wish to use student drawings as pictures in other projects, they need to first be saved as an image. Once saved as a .jpg, you can use the pictures in iPhoto, Keynote, Garageband for podcasts, in iWeb web pages, and in slide shows to share.

Save one drawing as an Image:

- Open the Pixie project.



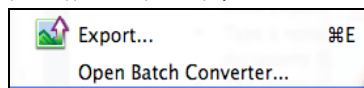
- Click on the Export button
- Change the .png to .jpg



- Click Export
- Type a name for the image and select where you want to save it. Students will save in the documents folder.
- The image will save in the documents folder with the .jpg at the end.
- Once it is a .jpg, you can then just drag it into most any project, or drag it into iPhoto as part of your photo library.

Save a folder of Pixie drawings as Images:

- You will first have to save each Pixie drawing into the same folder. (Just like you do for a Pixie slide show.)
- From the File Menu at the top of the screen, select Batch Converter:



- Click Choose Folder and navigate to the folder of images in your documents folder.
- Click on Choose destination and select where you want to save the new images.
- Click on Convert. You will have a new folder with the .jpg images to use in other projects.
