



Quick Tips for Posting Student Work to the Internet for iWeb '08

Student projects have to be in text, image, or movie format to be included on your iWeb site. See the full directions at http://www.danbury.k12.ct.us/elemweb/elemweb/How_To.html for a more step-by-step process.

iPhoto

As a movie:

- Create a book in iPhoto and export to iDVD as a movie.
- Drag the movie onto the movie page.

As a PDF

- From the Print screen, Print to a pdf file and save.
- In iWeb, make a hyperlink to the pdf.
- This allows viewers to print the book at home.

Keynote

As a Podcast page:

- From the Keynote File Menu, select Share to > iWeb > Podcast.

As a movie:

- From the Keynote File Menu, select Export
- Select Quicktime and save as a web movie small and drag the movie on the web page.

Kidspiration

- From the File Menu, select Export
- Click on .jpg and Save
- Use the image on any web page or add it to iPhoto to use in other projects.

Numbers

- Spreadsheet/Graphs - from the File Menu, select Export > to PDF.
- Make a link on the web page to the pdf file.

Pages

- Word processing and Desktop publishing (newsletters, brochures) File > Export as a pdf file.
- Make a link on the web page to the pdf file.

Pixie

- Export the drawings as .jpg and drag them onto the photos page. They will show as a slide show on the web.
- You can also add them to iPhoto to be used in other projects such as Keynote.

WebBlender

As a web page:

- Students publish their site.
- Students Hand IN the site to the teacher in the Groups folder to put into his/her sites folder. The teacher then links to those published pages.

As individual images:

- Create a new folder on the desktop to hold the images.
- Export all the pages as Images to that folder.
- Drag the images onto the photos page.
