



Publish iPhoto book to the Internet

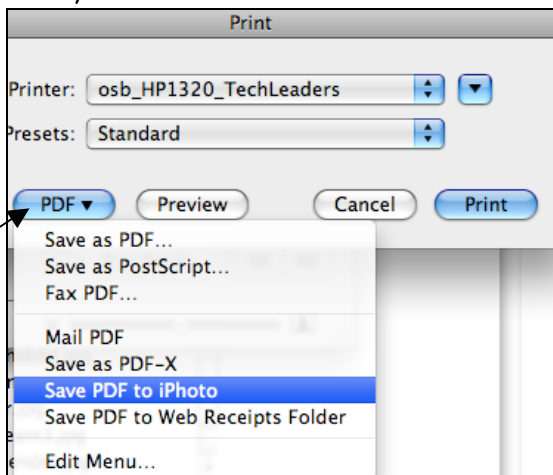
Remember that you do not want to publish full-faced photos of students on the web or include students who do not have permission to be on the web. Check the AUP carefully!

To put your book on the web (as a printable book):

1. Make a PDF of the book (a format that any computer can read.) From the File Menu, select Print, but don't click on the Print button. Instead, select Save to PDF. (see illustration below)
2. It will make set of pages that can be linked on your web site as a printable book. In iWeb, use the Hyperlink Inspector > Link to a File to link to the PDF book.

To put your book on the web (as individual images on the iWeb photo page):

1. Make a PDF of the book (a format that any computer can read.) From the File Menu, select Print, but don't click on the Print button. Instead, select Save to PDF in iPhoto.



2. This process will take a "photo" of each book page and save it back into iPhoto as separate photographs. It takes awhile, so be patient!
3. Open iWeb and create a photo page. Drag each photo page of the book from the Media/photos window onto the iWeb photo page. Once published to the web, viewers can see each page of the book with the text.

To create a movie of the book:

- To make a movie that includes the text of the book, go to the Share Menu and select send to iDVD.
- The movie of the book will save into your movies folder.
- You can then use the movie on your web page, or simply show it on your classroom computer during Open House.
