

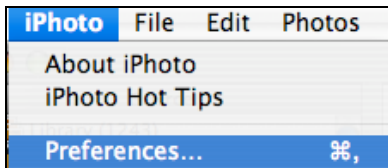
Sharing iPhoto Libraries



Students can use your iPhoto library if you choose to share it out. They can see the actual shared album in their own iPhoto library when on our network. This process can be used in place of exporting your photos and putting them in the Hand Out folder. However, the photo album will only be available when your iPhoto library is open. When you log out, it is gone from the student's library.

How to Share:

- Open your own iPhoto library.
- Create an album with the photos you wish your students (or other teachers) to use.
- From the iPhoto menu at the top of the screen, select Preferences.

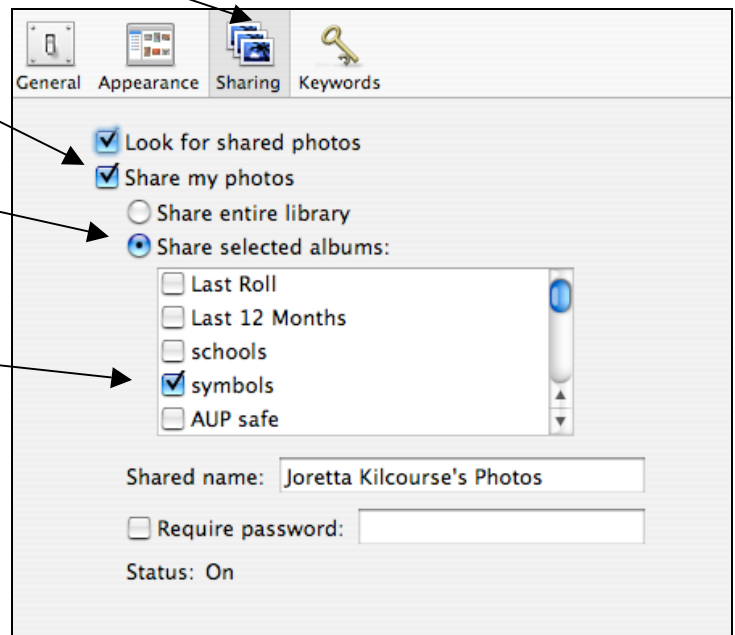


- In the Preferences window, click on Sharing:

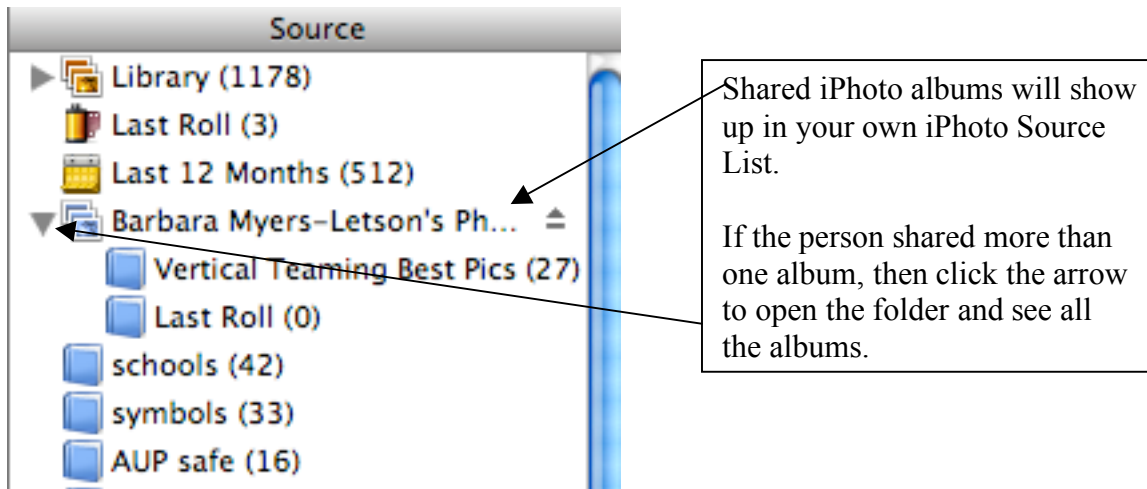
Click Share my photos

Click Share selected albums.

Check the album (or albums) you want the kids to see and use.



Your album will show up in the list of albums on the left side of the students iPhoto window.



- Students can just click on the shared album to see and use the shared photos.
- Drag the photos you want into an album on your own iPhoto library. (Remember that the teacher's iPhoto albums are only available when the teacher is logged in and has iPhoto open.)

When you log out, you will get a message asking if you wish to disconnect the shared albums. Click OK.
