

Saving Drawings as .JPG in Appleworks Draw

You can create an image in Appleworks Draw and save it as an image to be used in other applications, such as a web page. The trick is saving it correctly!

Create a new Appleworks Draw page. (not Word Processing!)

- Create your picture using the draw or paint tools. You can combine the clippings with your own art work too.
- When the drawing is completed, save the page in the regular way with a file name something like bus.cwk. (the .cwk means it is an Appleworks file)
- You will use this original file if you want to make changes to your drawing later.



To save as a .jpg:

- From the File Menu, select SAVE AS.
- Change the File Format from



- You will then change the file name from .cwk to .jpg
- If both the file name and the File Format are changes, click save.
- The saved document will look something like this:



- The saved .jpg image can be then inserted into any document.
