


# Macintosh iBook with OSX Panther: Internet Explorer





## Set the Home Page

- In Internet Explorer, go to the  Menu bar, select **Explorer** > Preferences
- Type in the home page address. Your school home page or the Elementary page is suggested.

## Bookmarks (called "Favorites")


### To Make Favorites:

- Go to the page you wish to add. On the  menu bar: Favorites > Add Page to Favorites  
OR
- Look on the left side of the screen, where you see a long vertical bar. Click on "Favorites."


The side will expand. Click , and it will add it to the list of Favorites.

- To close the Favorites window, click on the word "Favorites" again.

### • To Rename/View/Delete Favorites:


- To view saved Favorites, click on the Favorites tab on the left vertical bar .
- Select a Favorite, and point the cursor at its , and hold down the for 1 second.
- When the menu bar appears, you can rename this favorite with a name you like better, OR delete the Favorite altogether.

### • To Organize Favorites:

- Click on the Favorites tab on the left vertical bar.
- Click on Organize > Open Favorites Window
- Here you can drag your Favorites around to be in the order you wish them.
- To organize Toolbar Favorites, just drag the  to where you want it on the toolbar.

**History** - To see a list of all the sites you have recently visited, click History on the long vertical bar. You can click on any of these, and it will take you there. Close the History window by clicking on the word "History" again.

**Page Holder** - Internet Explorer has a useful feature for when you are viewing a page with a lot of links.

- Open Page Holder by clicking the tab on the long vertical bar.
- Click . Now all of the links on that page will be in the Page Holder window.
- As you surf through the links, you can just use the Page Holder instead of having to use the Back button to go back to find these links.
