

# Macintosh iBook with OSX Panther: Safari





Safari is a web browser for the Mac. It has some interesting features:

## Set the Home page

- In Safari, go to the Apple Menu and select Preferences
- Type in the home page address. Your school home page or the Elementary page is suggested.

## Make Bookmarks

List of Bookmarks

- Go to the page you wish to add and select Add Bookmark or click on Add Bookmark icon  in the toolbar.
- To view saved bookmarks, click on the Show bookmarks icon  in the Bookmark Bar.
- To delete bookmarks, show the bookmarks list, select the unwanted bookmark, and press Delete.

Bookmark Bar

- Drag most often used sites to the bookmark bar for easy access.
- To delete bookmarks from the Bookmark Bar, hold down the Control key and click on the unwanted bookmark. From the pop up menu, select Delete.



## Set Toolbar

To add icons in the toolbar, choose from the list in the View Menu.



**View History** - To see a list of all the sites you have recently visited, go to the View Menu and select History.

**Block Pop-Ups** - From the Safari Menu, select Block Pop-Ups

**Snapback** - The first page you open in a window is the SnapBack page. Safari remembers this page so you can quickly return to it after opening other webpages. Mark the Snapback page from the History Menu.

## Search with Google

- Click in the Google search box and type the search term. Press Return.
- Once in Google, you can also use the language tools to Translate words.
- Use the Images tab to find graphics of specific items.
- Once Google gives a list of sites, click on the search term in the Blue Bar to find a dictionary and thesaurus.
